Summary:

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to purchase of SciAps X-550 Pb HUD/EPA Lead Paint Analyzer – W provides Health department staff the ability test for lead paint, which improves the timeliness of receiving the test results. The \$24,675.00 cost of the equipment is fully funded by the grant. Case management for children (ages 0-15) and pregnant persons identified with a confirmed blood lead level at or greater than 5 micrograms per deciliter from July 1 - December 31, 2024, and at or greater than 3.5 micrograms per deciliter starting January 1, 2025, using the appropriate, available case management services to decrease to a manageable level in the identified child's elevated blood lead level through interventions into the causes of the lead poisoning.
