Summary:

On July 3, 2024 heavy equipment fell off a trailer in the Burlington at Bolcom roundabout (RAB) damaging the existing pavement structure along the NE quadrant of the RAB. KDOT Maintenance was quick to react and provide temporary repairs to the RAB in order to help keep traffic open and moving. However, due to the extent of the damage (6-inch deep gouges and tears in the existing pavement structure), a more robust and permanent repair is needed to help preserve the pavement structure throughout its current life cycle.

If repairs are not provided prior to winter, even greater damage to the pavement structure is at risk due to freeze/thaw effect damaging the pavement even more. Greater damage to the pavement structure will result in a greater cost to repair.

On August 20th, 2 bids were opened at KDOT for the above-mentioned project to repair the pavement of the Burlington Road at Bolcum Road roundabout.

The lowest qualified bid of \$97,434.16 was submitted by Curran Contracting Company of Crystal Lake, Illinois. Curran Contracting Company of Crystal Lake, Illinois is IDOT prequalified in Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Plant Mix (#003) as required in the contract specifications.

Kane County Division of Transportation staff reviewed the bid submitted to determine compliance with the Kane County Ordinance. After review of the bid, it was determined that the bid submitted did not meet all guidelines set forth within the Responsible Bidder Ordinance (RBO) provisions of the Kane County Purchasing Ordinance. Consistent with the terms of the RBO, the bid was then reviewed for compliance with the remaining sections of the Kane County Purchasing Ordinance. After completing this review, KDOT is recommending approval of the low bidder Curran Contracting Company.

This project has an anticipated completion of fall 2024, weather permitting and is entirely locally funded.

Staff recommends approval.
