Summary:

The City of Elgin and the County are proposing an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to cooperate regarding intersection improvements at Randall and Big Timber Road. Pursuant to the proposed IGA, the City agrees to relocate municipal utilities in consultation with the County, in order to avoid highway and utility conflicts.

The relocation of municipal utilities are to be included in the highway improvement contract and the City agrees to reimburse the County for construction and construction engineering costs related to the watermain relocation. The total estimated cost for construction of the City of Elgin municipal utility relocation is \$2,739,200.00. The cost of construction engineering will be calculated at 10% of the construction costs associated with the City of Elgin municipal utility relocation.

The City also agrees to vacate/abandon an existing permanent and exclusive easement for their municipal watermain to accomodate the proposed intersection improvements. The County agrees to replace the existing permanent easement and grant to the City of Elgin a new easement within the new right-of-way limits. A segment of the City of Elgin watermain on the west leg of Randall Road will be constructed within this new permanent easement.

Staff recommends approval.
