Summary:

The following proposed speed limit alteration has been determined in accordance with Kane County Resolution No. 01-419 (Policy for the Establishment and Posting of Altered Speed Limits on County and Township Roads) and is being submitted for approval in accordance with 625 5/11-604 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

At the request of the Elgin Township Road District, an engineering investigation was performed for the roads in Elgin Township:

- Bittersweet Lane (Hopps Road to Gingerwood Lane)
- Gingerwood Lane (Bittersweet Lane south to dead end)
- Hopps Road (Nolan Road west to dead end)
- Kristin Drive (Stevens Road to Gingerwood Lane)
- Pasec Place (Bittersweet Lane to dead end)
- Taos Place (Bittersweet Lane to dead end)

Currently these roads are posted at 30mph (per Ordinance 05-95). The County's speed limit policy does allow for a further reduction in speed limit for subdivision roads, like those above (i.e., roads that facilitate a group of dwellings exclusively for residential use served by an internal street system that isn't part of the County highway system). The Highway Commissioner has requested these roads be set at 25mph.

Staff recommends approval.
