REPORTS

33 reports were taken from 170 dispatched calls for service.

CITATIONS & WARNINGS ISSUED

Forty-five (45) citations issued: State Ordinance Citations (2); Local Ordinance Citations (36); Warning Tickets (7).

REPORT HIGHLIGHT SYNOPSIS

Personal Injuries

While attending a summer camp at LeRoy Oakes, one of the playing children tripped and fell, hitting her head. She complained of head pain and feeling sick. An ambulance was called to the scene and she was transported to Delnor Hospital for evaluation and treatment.

A man was driving a motorcycle on the roadway at Johnson's Mound, when he lost control and fell from his bike. The man suffered injuries and was transported to Delnor Hospital for treatment.

A bicyclist was at Raceway Woods, when his front wheel slipped, causing him to fall and injure his rib and arm. The man was treated by Carpentersville Fire Department and declined to be transported for further observation or treatment.

While walking along the trail at Big Rock near Siegler Lake, a female patron twisted her ankle. Big Rock Fire Department was called to the scene and transported the woman to Mercy Hospital for treatment.

A man was riding his bike along the Fox River Trail in South Elgin, when he came upon a large downed tree across the trail from a recent storm. The man attempted to stop, but slid on the wet pavement and fell to the ground, sustaining a cut under his eye. The man was picked up by his wife and sought treatment on his own. Officers taped off the area with caution tape while Operations staff promptly responded to the scene and removed the hazard.

A man was riding along the Fox River Trail in Elgin, when speaker wires attached to the man's bike became tangled in the spokes of his tire, causing him to crash. The man sustained an injury to his right shoulder and road rash across his body. He was transported to Sherman Hospital for treatment.

A woman was at Hughes Creek Golf Club, when she fell and dislocated her hip. She was transported to Delnor Hospital for treatment by Elburn EMS.

Dumping & Arrest Warrants

Staff came across a couch, brown wooden dresser, and numerous trash bags heaping from the dumpster at Glenwood. The majority of bags contained construction remnants from flooring and trimming. A possible offender address was located amongst the trash. Investigation is ongoing.

While on patrol at Campton FP, an officer came upon a man placing a wooden bed headboard against the preserve dumpster. The officer approached the man and informed him it was illegal to dump his garbage at our preserves. At one point during the investigation, the man took off running. The officer called for backup to pursue the offender. The officer searched the man's vehicle and found the man's ID, syringes, and numerous small baggies with white powdery residue, which later tested positive for heroin. The fleeing offender had 2 active warrants for his arrest. The offender was not located. Subsequent investigation positively identified the offender, his truck was towed, and a judge issued a court summons for the offender.

Disorderly Conduct & Indecent Exposure

Officers responded to Fabyan West after a report of a teenage girl being inappropriately touched by a male subject. The offender, a juvenile male, rode by the girl on the trail and slapped her buttocks with his hand. A separate victim, an adult female, was able to capture a short video clip of the offender after the incident she experienced. The juvenile offender was located, and detained after being positively identified by both victims. Neither victim wished to pursue charges. The

juvenile offender's parents were contacted and the offender was transported home at their request. The offender was cited for Disorderly Conduct and was released to his parents.

While on patrol at Brunner Family FP, an officer found a man jogging along the trail naked, with only a backpack, socks, and running shoes on. The officer stopped the man, had him dress, and issued him a citation for indecent exposure.
