If not budgeted, explain funding source: The Juvenile Justice Center will terminate a separate, existing contract (Reso. 23-57) with Family Counseling Services to provide mental health services for JJC employees, (\$9,900) annually, to account for the additional cost to retain Family Counseling Services to provide psychiatric and mental health services for detained youth.

Summary:

On July 13, 2021, the county board approved Resolution No. 21-328 allowing the Juvenile Justice Center to enter into an agreement with Family Counseling Services to provide mental health and psychiatric services for detained youth. That resolution was a three (3) year contract with two (2) additional one-year renewal periods if mutually agreed upon. On June 11, 2024, the county board approved Resolution No. 24-240 allowing the Juvenile Justice Center to extend the contract with Family Counseling Services for one year. On November 11, 2024, the county board approved Resolution No. 24-493 amending the current Contract for Professional Psychiatric Services for the Juvenile Justice Center at a new contract cost of Fifty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$55,317.00) per year. That agreement has elapsed and the Juvenile Justice Center would like to enter in to a new three (3) year contract with Family Counseling Services to provide mental health and psychiatric services for detained youth. The annual cost will go from Fifty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$55,317.00) per year to Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) per year.
