### **Summary:**

Staff is seeking approval to expand its existing OpenGov Asset Management system through the addition of a Stormwater Management module and associated professional services for implementation. This investment is necessary to meet updated Illinois EPA MS4 requirements, which mandate more detailed, standardized, and auditable tracking of stormwater assets, inspections, maintenance activities, and system conditions. Current processes rely heavily on manual tracking and reporting, creating inefficiencies and increasing the risk of non-compliance.

The proposed solution will centralize stormwater data, automate reporting, and integrate with the County's existing GIS and asset management workflows. Professional services will support configuration, data migration, training, and system deployment over an estimated nine-month implementation period.

The total cost for the software and services is \$62,955.89, which will improve operational efficiency, reduce administrative burden, and position the County for long-term regulatory compliance and data-driven infrastructure management.
