The Kane County Board's Development Committee met in Closed Session on Tuesday, December 20, 2022, in the County Board Room, Bldg. "A", Kane County Government Center.

ROLL CALL: Ford, Williams, Berman, Daugherty*, Iqbal*, Kenyon, Linder, Davoust, Kiou. Also Present: Co. Bd. Members Allan*, Bates*, Roth, Strathmann*, Tepe; ASA Brady.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: The Development Committee moved into Executive Session at 10:50 a.m. to discuss the release of Closed Session minutes motioned by Kiou, seconded by Linder. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.
