Kane County Farmer Weatherization Rebate Program: Application

Important Note: If the following rebate application is approved by Kane County staff for the amount of \$800, the applicant must submit a W-9 to Kane-DuPage Soil & Water Conservation District before the check can be disbursed. All rebates over \$600 are considered taxable income by the IRS.


Therefore, KDSWCD must collect a W-9 and send the applicant a 1099 form before the upcoming tax filling season.

Farmer Outreach - Soil Testing and Financial Analysis

Outreach Objectives

- Recruit up to 10 farmers for soil health testing
- Select 2-3 farmers to conduct scenario testing based on shared financial and operating data



Cornell Soil Health Laboratory
Home of the Comprehensive
Assessment of Soil Health

Standard PLUS Soil Health Analysis Package

Testing covers multiple factors including:

- Soil pH, Organic Matter, P, K
- Soil Respiration
- Soil Organic Carbon, Total Carbon, Total Nitrogen

Cost: \$150 per sample and \$30 for Available Water Capacity Analysis per sample
